On June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 Educational Assistants, Student Support Workers and Itinerant ABLE Workers gathered at St. Michael CHS, Kemptville for a professional development day. They met in the gym for a liturgy and then broke off into smaller sessions to facilitate group sharing and collaboration. The Educational Assistants learned more about assistive technology, proactive strategies and reinforcement. They had the opportunity to share successful ideas they used to help students achieve success and shared these ideas through the PIC collage app. The Student Support Workers and Itinerant ABLE Workers discussed anxiety and the development of PTRs. Participants examined student profiles and case studies to share successes and to problem solve difficult situations. Overall, the day was very successful.
