Your task on the OSSLT

- decide whether you agree or disagree with the statement
- think of reasons why you hold that opinion (try to come up with at least three), and an example from your own experience which supports each reason
- write an introductory paragraph, making sure it clearly states your opinion

Your task on the OSSLT

- write at least three body paragraphs which gives your reasons for your opinion and the examples from your own experience
- write a concluding paragraph which summarizes your opinion

Take a stance!

- Read the topic and choose either to agree or disagree with the statement
- Do not choose to argue both sides; While you may see both sides of the argument, the purpose of an opinion piece is to argue only one side of the issue
- Choose a side where you can come up with at least 3 strong reasons and examples

Make a Plan!

- Good writing starts with making a wellorganized plan
- Outline your three main arguments. Each argument = a body paragraph
- Next, provide details and examples that will go into your paragraph
- Once you have completed a detailed and organized plan, it is much easier to write an opinion piece!
